Busy (Busy Internet) is a fixed and wireless broadband provider operating in Ghana. The company was formed in 2001 as an ADSL internet service provider. Previously owned by **Afrimax Group**, the company was sold to Dubai-headquartered AI Technologies, with Afrimax maintaining a minority share.

The company launched a 4G LTE network in January 2016 over the B40 (2300 MHz) band.
