Fiji is a member of the ITU and as such follows radio frequency harmonisation principles according to ITU-R [Region-3](#). The regulatory body governing communications policy is the Attorney-General's Chambers who is also charged with regulating the country's radio frequency spectrum activities such as planning, allocations, and licencing.
